YORK REVOLUTION (4-13) vs. Somerset Patriots (9-9)

Game #19 - Friday, May 15, 2009

Sovereign Bank Stadium - York, PA

LHP Dave Gassner (0-3, 10.24) vs. RHP Jared Gothreaux (1-2, 6.19)

RevITUP! Tonight the Revs begin the second half of their two-series homestand, with the first of three against the Patriots. York enters play in last place, 8.5 games out in the Freedom Division. Somerset is in 2nd, 4.0 games behind Newark.

Rain Rain Go Away: Last night's rubber match between the Revs and 'Fish was postponed due to rain with the game scoreless in the bottom of the 2nd. No makeup date has been announced. It is already York's 4th rainout of the season (all home games), which is approaching a franchise record for most in one season. The Revs had 5 rainouts in 2007 (3 at home), and 6 last season (2 at home) in addition to one suspended game at home last year. The quest for the first series win in 2009 will have to wait at least a couple of more days. The Revs have played the fewest games of any team in the league.

Drawing First Blood: The Revs are 3-3 in series openers this season (2-1 at home). The Revs are 0-6 in second games, and 0-4 in third games however.

Not Again: Each of the last two times the Revs have won a game (April 26, May 4), it's been followed with five consecutive losses. With Wednesday's loss (following Tuesday's win), the Revs still have not won back-to-back games, and are 0-4 following victories this season.

Bats in Hibernation: The Revs have scored the fewest runs in the league at 59, 17 fewer than any other team. They have scored three runs or fewer 11x (1-11), and two runs or fewer 8x (0-8).

Something's Missing: Over the last three games, the Revs' 2-4 hitters in the order are a combined 5-for-34 (.147) with 1 RBI. The #3 hitter alone the last three games is 0-for-11 with 0 RBI.

Some Bright Spots: The Revs own three of the league's top seven hitters (Tom Collaro 3rd-.391, Matt Padgett 6th-.353, Kennard Jones 7th-.345). Four of the league's top seven, and five of the top 10 will partake in tonight's game, as Somerset boasts Noah Hall (4th-.364) and Matt Hagen (10th-.328) as part of their lineup.

Matt Being Matt: Matt Esquivel scored five of the Revs' six runs in the Bridgeport series, and Matt Padgett has driven in four of the six. One of the two Matts has in some way contributed on all six. Esquivel homered in the opener, and Padgett homered the following night.

What a Relief: The Revs received some relief on Wednesday when they signed RHP Travis Hughes. The former big-leaguer made his debut that night with a 1-2-3 eighth inning and two strikeouts. With Steve Andrade temporarily on the shelf and Dan Foli plucked into starting duty due to Rick Bauer's departure, the Revs had been operating with just five relievers, and only three right-handers. The bullpen worked four scoreless innings Wednesday (Holliday 2.0, Hughes 1.0, Kershner 1.0), and retired each of the final eight batters. The 'pen has allowed just one run over 7.1 IP on the homestand.

Now is the Time: The Revs are just 2-5 at home, but are looking to finish the homestand strong after tying for the second-best home record in the league last season (43-28 tied LI, 1GB SMD). Every other team in the league has at least five wins at home already.

Grudge Match: The Revs are looking for revenge after being swept at Somerset last weekend, and being outscored 29-8 in the three games. The Revs now trail the all-time series 19-22 (9-10 home, 10-12 road).

Struggles Mounding: The Revs hold the league's highest ERA at 6.48, about 1.5 runs higher than the next club (LAN-4.86), and have allowed a league-high 190 hits for a .318 opponents batting average and .395 OBP. York has allowed double-digit hits in 13 games this season (2-11). The starting staff is still looking for its first win (0-10) and has allowed 50 hits over 25.1 IP the last 6 games, after allowing fewer hits than innings in 7 of the first 11 games and 6 of the first 8. The Revs have been outscored 31-5 in the 4th inning of games, and 20-4 in the 5th (51-9 combined). The Revs have been outscored 125-59 overall for the season. Seven different times, a pitcher has allowed six or more runs, and the team has allowed 10 or more in a game on five occasions. On the bright side, the Revs are 3rd in the league in strikeouts (118) after leading the league in that department a year ago.

Slow Start: York's 4-13 start is the worst 17-game start in franchise history (9-8 in 2007, 7-20 in 2008). The Revs have stumbled out of the gate in each of the first two seasons (0-4, 11-20, 21-36 in 2007... 0-3, 8-20 in 2008). York is 21-43 all-time in the month of May (10-14 in 2007, 9-21 in 2008, 2-8 this season). The Revs have been a much better second half team in both campaigns, finishing 32-31 (23-15 at one point) in 2007, and last season, authoring the best half of any team in the league in the second half, earning the franchise's first-ever playoff berth with a 41-29 record.

Spreading the Wealth: In 17 games, Chris Hoiles has used 16 different lineups. Game one of last Thursday's DH was the first time he had used the same lineup more than once (same as last Monday night's winning lineup).

Wellspan Health Injury Update: Closer Steve Andrade is day-to-day with right biceps tendinitis.

This Date in York Baseball History: May 15, 2007 - The Revs play as the home team for the first time ever, beating the Road Warriors 7-5 in Camden, in front of 17 fans, three birds, and a squirrel. The game was played exactly one month prior to the opening of Sovereign Bank Stadium.

Last Start:

- Lost 16-2 at Somerset on Sunday... 3+IP, 10H, 11R, 4ER, 4BB, 4K... walked four in one inning (3rd) for the first time in his career, leading to a Travis Anderson grand slam... Josh Pressley clubbed a slam in the fourth, as the Pats scored 7 in back-to-back innings... Gassner's first two innings were scoreless, and he picked off Sean Smith in the first, moving into a tie with Wayne Franklin for most pickoffs (5) by a pitcher in Revs history.

Last Year Vs. Somerset:

- Made his second start in a Revs uniform at TD Bank Ballpark, and lost 2-1... allowed just two runs on eight hits in seven innings... did not walk anyone and struck out five.

Unearned:

- The Revs have made a total of 8 errors in Gassner's three starts, leading to 12 unearned runs against him (23R, 11ER).

Missed Opportunity:

- Gassner appeared to be getting back on track when he took the mound on Wednesday, May 6, allowing just one run in three solid innings of work... that start was rained out in the bottom of the third, however, and he ended up missing a turn in the rotation, leading up to Sunday's start at Somerset.

2008:

- Returns to York after making 7 starts with the Revs early last season (2-3, 3.06)
- Contract purchased by the Red Sox on June 4 and assigned to Double-A Portland for remainder of season (8-5, 5.82)
- Lost first four decisions with Portland but won final seven... allowed just three runs in final four appearances (19.0 IP)
- Faced just one over minimum firing five shutout innings in his York debut, May 3, 2008 vs. Long Island
- Carried shutout into 8th (7.2 IP) for first York win, May 13, 2008 vs. Newark
- Allowed 3 ER or less in 6 of his 7 starts with York last season
- Posted a 21-inning walkless streak, May 3-18, 2008
- Picked off 4 runners in his first 5 starts with York
- Appeared in spring camp with Cincinnati Reds
- Originally agreed with the Camden Riversharks but began 2008 in Taiwan, becoming an Atlantic League free agent

Previous Career:

- Spent all of 2007 with Rochester, ranking 4th in the IL in starts... tossed CG 4-hit shutout May 26, 2007 vs. Durham
- Missed most of 2006 with left elbow strain
- Made MLB debut with the Twins on April 16, 2005 at Jacobs Field, beating Kevin Millwood 6-4 (6 IP, 3H, 1ER)... struck out Travis Hafner for first big league K... retired 10 of final 11 BF... joined Eric Milton (1998) and Scott Erickson (1990) as only the third Twins pitcher since 1980 to win his big league debut
- Named AAA All-Star in 2004, and named to International League's Post-Season All-Star team... led league in wins (16-8, 3.41 with Rochester)
- Acquired by Minnesota as player to be named in July 13, 2003 trade with Toronto in which the Twins received OF Shannon Stewart in exchange for OF Bobby Kielty
- Selected to Eastern League All-Star Game and led league in ERA in 2003 with New Haven (10-4, 2.79)
- Was a teammate of Mike Smith, Corey Thurman, and Jason Kershner in the Blue Jays organization
- Drafted by Toronto in the 24th round of the 2001 draft

- Pitched four seasons at Purdue University where he was named all Big Ten as a senior in 2001... graduated in 2002 with a degree in Education.
