YORK REVOLUTION (3-10) at Somerset Patriots (5-8)

Game #14 - Saturday, May 9, 2009

TD Bank Ballpark - Bridgewater, NJ

RHP Dan Foli (0-1, 11.37) vs. RHP Jared Gothreaux (0-2, 7.20)

WUPTUP! Tonight the Revs play the middle of a three-game weekend road series at Somerset. York enters play in last place, 6.0 games out in the Freedom Division. Somerset is 4.0 games behind first-place Newark. The Revs have lost 8 of their last 9, while Somerset snapped a four-game losing streak with last night's win.

Last Night: The Revs dropped the opener at Somerset 8-3. Noah Hall blasted two homers and drove in six. The Revs had leadoff hits in each of the first five innings, but only managed three runs and left 10 runners on. Brian Adams improved to 8-0 all-time against York.

Just Jonesing: Kennard Jones went 4-for-5 last night with his first homer, and a triple. His nine total bases are the most by a Revs hitter this season, and his four-hit game is the first of the year. He has now homered three times in his career at TD Bank Ballpark, and all three have been hit to centerfield. KJ also went 4-for-5 with a homer on August 30, 2008 at Lancaster, and went 6-for-6 with a walk-off homer, June 30, 2008 vs. Newark. Jones now ranks 3rd in the league with a .386 batting average.

Scalding: Tom Collaro has been of the league's hottest hitters to begin 2009, having hit safely in all nine games he's played with five multi-hit games. He currently ranks second in the league with a .452 average and a .677 slugging clip. He leads the league in on-base percentage at .553.

Homers for Everyone: Jones' homer last night gives the Revs a team total of seven on the season, hit by seven different players. No one has yet connected on their second homerun.

Not Quite Adding Up: The Revs are third in the league with a .270 batting average, but are tied for the fewest runs scored with 48 (tied with Somerset).

Missed Opportunity: The Revs went just 1-4 on the rain-shortened five-game homestand. It was a disappointing way to begin the home schedule, after the Revs tied for the second-best home record in the league last season (43-28 tied LI, 1GB SMD). The Revs will return home for a six-game homestand following this weekend's trip.

Disturbing Trend: The opponent has scored the game's first run in each of the last six games, and it has come in the 3rd inning or earlier every game (four times in the first inning). The Revs are 1-8 when the opponent scores first. The opponent has scored first in 9 of the 13 games overall this season.

Returning to the Scene of the Crime: The Revs return to the place where they were ousted in last year's Freedom Division Series, but York had won back-to-back series (4 of 6) on the road at Somerset in the second half of 2008, en route to the division title. The all-time series is led by Somerset 20-19, and tied 10-10 in Bridgewater.

Milestone Homerun: Jason Aspito's next homerun will be the 100th of his pro career. He clubbed his first of the season on Friday night which pushed him into sole possession of the Revs' all-time lead with 36 (entered the season tied with Matt Dryer). Aspito bombed 24 blasts last season, a Revolution single-season record.

Struggles Mounding: The Revs hold the league's highest ERA at 6.69, and have allowed a league-high 144 hits and 56 walks. They have struck out the second most at 92. The starting staff is still looking for its first win (0-7). The bullpen has claimed all three wins, but has an 8.28 ERA. The Revs have been outscored 23-3 in the 4th inning of games, and 14-4 in the 5th. Five different times, a pitcher has allowed six or more runs.

Slow Start: York's 3-10 start is the worst in franchise history. The Revs have stumbled out of the gate in each of the first two seasons (0-4, 11-20, 21-36 in 2007... 0-3, 8-20 in 2008). York is 20-40 all-time in the month of May (10-14 in 2007, 9-21 in 2008, 1-5 this season). The Revs have been a much better second half team in both campaigns, finishing 32-31 (23-15 at one point) in 2007, and last season, authoring the best half of any team in the league in the second half, earning the franchise's first-ever playoff berth with a 41-29 record.

Spreading the Wealth: In 13 games, Chris Hoiles has used 12 different lineups. Game one of Thursday's DH was the first time he had used the same lineup more than once (same as Monday night's winning lineup).

This Date in York Baseball History: May 9, 2007 - York clobbers Camden 17-6 at Campbell's Field for the first win in franchise history. Nate Espy goes 4-for-4 with 2HR, 7RBI, and 5R. Tike Redman was 5-for-5 and scored three times.

- Faced the Patriots several times in relief last season, and also made two starts at TD Bank Ballpark, going 1-0... he beat the Patriots on August 15, allowing four runs in seven innings of a 7-6 comeback victory, highlighted by Jason Aspito's grand slam.

2008:

- Went 7-7 with a 4.98 ERA in 40 appearances and 9 starts with the Revolution... matched career-highs in victories and games.
- First 30 appearances came in relief before joining starting rotation... was his first time in a regular rotation since 2003.
- York went 6-3 in his nine starts... posted a 3.60 ERA in his first three starts
- Was brilliant on Labor Day at Bridgeport, allowing just a run on four hits in seven innings
- Earned his biggest win on Sept. 16 at Newark, allowing one run in six innings as the Revs lowered their magic number to three with a 5-3 win.
- Worked out of bases loaded jams in relief on consecutive nights, becoming the first Revolution pitcher to win back-to-back games, June 27-28 vs. Long Island
- ERA would have been 4.44 if not for a start at Southern Maryland on August 20 when he allowed 7ER in 2.1 IP.

Previous Career:

- 9th pro season... has reached AAA twice... drafted by the Cubs in the 31st round of the 2001 draft... has pitched in the Cubs, Mets, Nationals, and Astros organizations.
- Pitched one game for his father, former MLB infielder Tim Foli, when he was the manager of Triple-A New Orleans in 2006; earned a three-inning save in that outing

- Never played organized baseball until his freshman year of college due to travel... was homeschooled as the family traveled to wherever his father Tim was playing... grew up in Daytona Beach during the off-seasons
- Graduate of A. Beka Video High School in Pensacola, FL; attended Walters State (TN) Community College.
