YORK REVOLUTION (21-41) at Long Island Ducks (32-29)

Game #63 - Wednesday, July 1, 2009

Citibank Park - Central Islip, NY

LHP Dave Gassner (3-6, 4.73) vs. RHP Julio Manon (3-1, 3.68)

RevITUP! Tonight the Revs continue a seven-game road swing with the rubber game of three at Long Island. York has won 5 of 7, including 4 of 6 out of the All-Star break, all against first or second place teams. The Revs are seeking their first road series win. They are 2-2 in rubber games this season (0-1 on the road).

Last Night: The Revs lost 8-2 at Long Island, despite Matt Esquivel's 3-for-3 night, including a homerun.

Close Calls: Four of York's last five wins have come in one-run games. The Revs are tied with Newark for best record in one-games at 10-5. Bob Zimmermann has saved all four, each time nailing it down against the middle of the opposing team's batting order. He has stranded the tying runner on-base in three straight, and in scoring position in each of the last two (both 6-5 wins). Monday was the 50th save of his career, and he pulled into a tie with Travis Phelps for the club lead this season.

Bat's More Like It! York has scored 32 runs (5.3) in the 6 games since the All-Star break, and has batted .319 (66-207) as a team. The Revs have had double-digit hits 4x in the 6 games, and have ripped 14 doubles, 4 triples, and 4 homers. They had scored just 10 total in the previous 5 games before the break. Over the last 8 games, 11x an opponent has scored, only to see the Revs answer with a run in the ensuing half-inning.

Changing of the Guard: With the additions of Olson and Rose last weekend, the Revs have now used 38 players already this season, including 21 pitchers. The Revs only used 42 players all of last season (22 pitchers), and just 44 in 2007 (21 pitchers).

Pitching In: Revs starters have allowed 4ER or less in 39 of the last 45 games, and in 51 of the 62 games this season. Starters have earned the decision in each of the last 5 wins, after starting the year 9-29 despite an ERA consistently in the 4's.

Rough Patch: The pitching has allowed 10+ hits in four straight, and 15 of the last 22. They've also allowed 5 homers the last 3 games, and 7 in the last 6 games. Opponents have scored 18 runs (6.0) the last 3 games, and starters have gone less than 6.0 IP in all three, after working 6+ in each of the previous four. The defense has also committed an error in 6 straight (10E) and 8 of the last 9.

Turn the Calendar Page: The Revs finish June at 11-17 (8-8 home, 3-9 road). Matt Rogelstad was the Revs' leading hitter in June (.333), with Josh Johnson not far behind at .315. Bob Zimmermann's four saves have set a Revs record for the month of June. The Revs are 30-25 all-time in July (19-11 in 2007, 11-14 last year).

Duck Hunting: The Revs are 4-5 vs. the Ducks this season, 1-4 at Citibank Park (3-1 home). The Revs are seeking back-to-back series wins against the Ducks (took 3 of 4 in York in early June). All-time, York is 26-21 against Long Island, 13-17 in Central Islip. The two clubs will next meet for a home-and-home on back-to-back weekends in mid-August.

Launching Pad: One Revs hitter should be licking his chops to return to Central Islip. Jason Aspito owns 9HR in 19 career games at Citibank Park, including 8 in his first 11 career games there. He has homered 10 times in his York career against Long Island, including beginning his Revs career back in 2007 with a homer at Long Island in his second game, and two more in his third game. Not to mention, he's due. York's last visit to Long Island at the end of May was the first time Aspito had gone a series without homering at Citibank Park, and he's yet to homer this week. He has only hit 1 HR in his last 8 games at Long Island.

Looking Ahead: The Revs have been a second half team in both of the first two seasons. York went 30-40 in the first half last season, but their 41-29 mark in the second half was the best record of any team in either half last year, earning the Revs their first ever playoff berth. In 2007, York closed the first half just 26-37, before a 32-31 second half (23-15 at one point), that had them in contention until the season's final week.

Spreading the Wealth: In 61 games, the Revs have used 54 different lineups.

This Date in York Baseball History: July 1, 2008 - The Revs honor Brooks Robinson prior to their game against Newark. The "Human Vacuum" was named to the Rawlings All-Time Gold Glove Team, and honored as the greatest third baseman ever.

Wellspring Health Injury Update: RHP Travis Hughes became the first player of the season to be placed on the DL Saturday. Hughes, battling a nagging hamstring problem, is on the DL retroactive to June 20.

Tonight's Starter: LHP Dave Gassner

Last Start: Beat Somerset 9-4 on Friday... line = 6.2 IP, 5H, 2R, 1ER, 3BB, 3K, 113 pitches... retired first six... worked out of bases loaded one-out jam in fourth... third time he had allowed just 1ER in a start.

Vs. Long Island: Lost at Long Island on May 30 despite allowing just 3ER in 6.0 IP... beat the Ducks at home on June 5, allowing just 2ER on only 4H in 7.0 IP (did not allow a hit in final three innings)... first three innings were scoreless in both outings... made his Revs debut vs. the Ducks last season at home, allowing just 4H in 5.0 shutout innings on May 3, 2008... 1-1, 2.50 ERA career vs. Long Island... 1-1, 3.46 ERA this season vs. Long Island.

Threes are Wild: Gassner has walked exactly three in back-to-back starts and four of the last five.

Quality Starts: Gassner, who had 4 straight quality starts from May 25-June 10, has earned 10 QS in his Revs career, T-4th most on the club's all-time list with Dave Gil and Chris Steinborn. He could tie Frank Castillo for #3 tonight with his 11th. Corey Thurman leads with 14.

2009:

Allowed just 1R in 3.0 IP but start was rained out, May 6 vs. SMD... Allowed a grand slam in consecutive innings, May 10 at SOM.. Allowed just one run in 8.0 IP, earning his first win, May 25 vs. CAM... allowed just one run in 7.0 IP, but took ND June 10 at NWK... 4 straight quality starts, May 25-June 10... worked 6.0+ IP in five straight starts, May 20-June 10... fought his way through 4.0 IP to save the bullpen, pitching with a stomach virus, June 15 vs. NWK.

- Returns to York after making 7 starts with the Revs early last season (2-3, 3.06)
- Contract purchased by the Red Sox on June 4 and assigned to Double-A Portland for remainder of season (8-5, 5.82)

- Originally agreed with the Camden Riversharks but began 2008 in Taiwan, becoming an Atlantic League free agent

- Spent all of 2007 with Rochester, ranking 4th in the IL in starts... tossed CG 4-hit shutout May 26, 2007 vs. Durham
- Missed most of 2006 with left elbow strain
- Made MLB debut with the Twins on April 16, 2005 at Jacobs Field, beating Kevin Millwood 6-4 (6 IP, 3H, 1ER)... struck out Travis Hafner for first big league K... retired 10 of final 11 BF... joined Eric Milton (1998) and Scott Erickson (1990) as only the third Twins pitcher since 1980 to win his big league debut
- Named AAA All-Star in 2004, and named to International League's Post-Season All-Star team... led league in wins (16-8, 3.41 with Rochester)
- Acquired by Minnesota as player to be named in July 13, 2003 trade with Toronto in which the Twins received OF Shannon Stewart in exchange for OF Bobby Kielty
- Selected to Eastern League All-Star Game and led league in ERA in 2003 with New Haven (10-4, 2.79)
- Was a teammate of Mike Smith, Corey Thurman, and Jason Kershner in the Blue Jays organization

Chris Britton - RHP

Signed June 10... began season at Double-A and Triple-A with San Diego going a combined 2-2 with a 10.45 ERA in 15 relief outings... pitched in 3 games in 2 days, including both games of day-night DH, earning save in nightcap with tying run on base, June 13 vs. LAN... 0ER last 7G (5.2 IP)... has not issued a walk all season.

Daryl Harang - LHP

Began season in 'pen; earned win in Revs' first two victories and his first two appearances (April 23 and 26 at BRG)... his win on Opening Night marked just the second time of career that he and older brother Aaron (Cincinnati Reds) both won on the same day... made 9 straight starts, after starting only once his entire career prior to this season (0-7, 5.36); posted 3 quality starts, and did not allow more than 5ER in any start... fired 6.0 shutout innings, stranding 10 runners on May 19 at CAM... worked 6.0+ in 5 of his starts... career-high 7.0 IP, June 9 at NWK (lost 2-1)... received just 2.2 runs of support per start... did not allowed a run in first 4.0 IP of relief... returned to 'pen on June 25; entered with bases loaded and no outs in 8th, and recorded K and GDP to keep one-run lead intact in York's 7-6 win vs. SOM.

Brian Holliday - LHP

Debuted with 2.0 no-hit innings April 25 at BRG... worked out of a bases-loaded one-out jam in the 10th for his first AL win, May 4 vs. SMD... did not allow a run in four straight outings (7.0 IP), May 4-16... retired 8-in-a-row, May 23 at NWK... worked out of a bases-loaded no-out jam May 26 vs. CAM... stranded his first 8 inherited runners... needs 36G for 200 career... has worked multiple innings 11x; 9 of those outings have been scoreless... has issued just 2 walks his last 10.0 IP / 8G.

Travis Hughes - RHP

Signed/activated May 13... retired first 6BF with 4K... needs 32G for 500 in pro career, 29K for 1000.

Jason Kershner - LHP

Struck out 6 in 4.2 IP, and retired 13 of final 14 BF, May 2 vs. LAN... retired 12 of 14 BF in 4.0 IP, May 9 at SOM (retired 32 of 36 at one point)... retired 11 straight, May 20-22... team-record 29.2-inning walkless streak to open season... 8.2 IP scoreless streak (4G) May 31-June 11... 12.2 IP w/o ER, May 31-June 16... fired a 1-2-3 eighth in the AL All-Star Game... Needs 20K for 1,000 in pro career... has worked multiple innings 14x (8 of last 9), and three-or-more innings 3x.

Jason Olson - RHP

Activated June 26, and made his return to York retiring all 4BF to finish that night's victory vs. SOM... has retired all 6BF since returning... is York's all-time leader in games (94) and relief wins (9). His 10 wins overall with York ranks 4th, 111K ranks T-5th with Dan Foli, and 129.2 IP ranks 8th... joins Keoni DeRenne, Jason Aspito, Luis Taveras, and Wayne Franklin to suit up for the Revs in all three seasons.

Travis Phelps - RHP

Allowed 4ER on April 30 at SMD and 3ER on June 11 at NWK, but just 9ER over 28.1 IP in his other 24 outings... 4 saves is his most since notching 5 with Huntsville (AA) in 2006; owns 29 career saves (5 in MLB)... retired 15 of 16, June 2-10 (12 straight June 5-10)... has pitched on back-to-back days 4x, allowing a run on the second day only once... owns a 2.63 ERA at home (13.2 IP, 4ER), but a 6.48 mark on the road (16.2 IP, 12 ER)... has allowed 8ER in 8.2 IP his last 7G (allowed run in 4 straight, 6 of last 7); also 9BB last 7G (0ER, only 1BB his previous 5.0 IP; 2ER prev. 12.2 IP)... has appeared in 58 games w/ York, 2nd most in club history; 3 relief wins is T-2nd most all-time with four others.

Bob Zimmermann - RHP

Began season in 'pen... had made four starts between relief appearances in May and June; went 2-0 with a 2.40 ERA in the first three... needs 15K for 300 career... 4SV (all in past week) have all come in one-run games; his first saves since 2006 (5 that year); Monday's was his 50th career.
